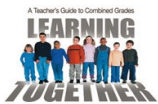

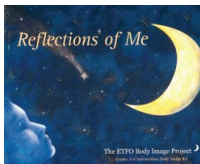
Learning Together: A Teacher's Guide to Combined Grades

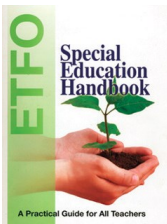
Planning for Student Learning

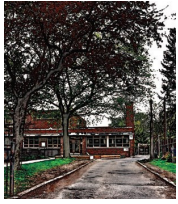
ETFO Special Education Handbook: A Practical Guide for All Teachers

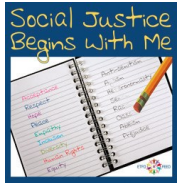
Think Before you Click DVD
