Unity in Action:

Province-Wide Strike by 200,000 ETFO, OSSTF, OECTA, AEFO Members on Friday, February 21

Province-wide full withdrawal of services strikes on Friday, February 21, 2020 -will see the participation by members of:

- Elementary Teachers' Federation of Ontario (ETFO) 83,000 members;
- Ontario Secondary School Teachers' Federation (OSSTF) 60,000 members;
- Ontario English Catholic Teachers' Association (OECTA) 45,000 members; and
- l'Association des enseignantes et enseignants franco-ontariens (AEFO) 12,000 members.

For the first time since 1997, all the affiliates of the Ontario Teachers' Federation will mobilize their members to take simultaneous action.

This unified action is meant to send a strong signal to the Ford government that teachers and education workers will not stand quietly by while it attempts to use the central bargaining process to rubber-stamp its agenda of destructive cuts and privatization.

Thinking of Retiring

You can apply for your pension up to 4 months in advance but remember, you may send all your required documents now:

- a photocopy of your birth certificate, Canadian passport or Ontario driver's license
- a photocopy of your spouse's birth certificate, Canadian passport or Ontario driver's license
- a photocopy of your marriage certificate

You should check your <u>service record</u> for absences in the last 5 years which you may qualify to buy back.

Our members that are currently on a leave and wanting to take a non-statutory leave for the teaching year of 2020/2021, need to have their letter of request by March 1st. Did You Know?

Did you know that March 1 is an important deadline? If you wish to apply for a Deferred Salary Leave Plan (Article 26), Leave of Absence Without Pay (Article 19), or receive \$150 for retiring at the end of the year (Article 18), your written application must be received by the board by March 1. Did you know prep time shall be allocated to teachers to be used for professional activities as determined by the teacher? Prep time is prorated with a 1.0 FTE teacher having 240 minutes per 5 day cycle in blocks of at least 30 minutes. (12.06 Preparation Time)
