The staffing process can be a confusing time for many. There are several steps and important dates within the process that impacted members must be aware of. For example, Article 29.02 Transfer of Surplus Teachers states that a teacher who has been declared surplus, and subsequently is transferred to another school, shall be given the opportunity to remain in his/her current school if a suitable vacancy effective for the following September arises on or before June 22 in the year in which the surplus and redundancy procedures are applied and provided the teacher is qualified to fill the vacancy. Be sure to read your Collective Agreement to ensure you understand the timeline of the staffing process.

Sign in to BabySteps with your Ontario Teachers' account to keep track of your buyback payments and deadlines.
