## CENTRAL BARGAINING UPDATE

July 20, 2022

Yesterday (Tuesday, July 19), representatives from ETFO attended two central bargaining meetings with representatives from school board bargaining agencies (i.e., the Ontario Public School Boards' Association and the Council of Trustees' Associations) and the Ministry of Education.

The first meeting concerned ETFO's Education Worker Central Table, where ETFO bargains on behalf of its Designated Early Childhood Educator, Educational Support Personnel and Professional Support Personnel members. Introductions were made and ground rules were discussed.

The second meeting was regarding ETFO's Teacher and Occasional Teacher Central Table. The content of this meeting mirrored what had taken place during the Education Worker Central Table meeting earlier in the day.

ETFO, school board bargaining agency and Ministry of Education representatives agreed to identify potential future meeting dates for central bargaining.
